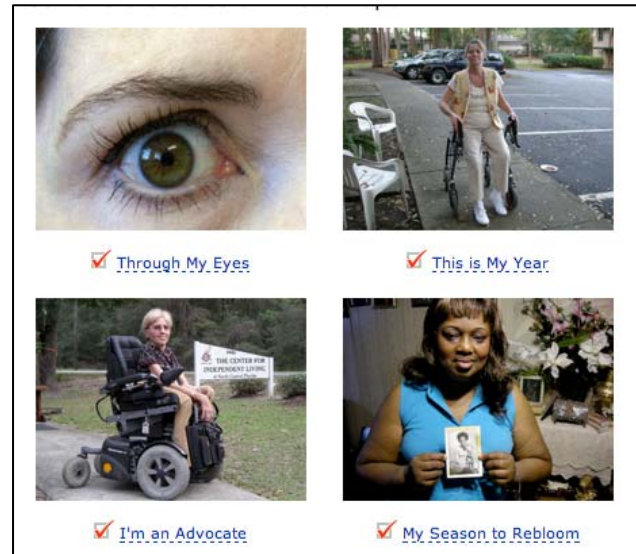

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IMPROVING ACCESS AND CARE FOR PATIENTS WITH PHYSICAL DISABILITIES

Learning Objectives:

- **State several barriers and facilitators that people living with physical disabilities might encounter when seeking health care.**
- **Identify at least four things that could improve the quality of health care for people living with physical disabilities.**

SUMMARY

The goal of this session is to improve health care professionals’ understanding of the issues that impact the quality of health care provided to people living with physical disabilities. This educational website consists of four narrated slideshows, or “Photo-maps”, that women with physical disabilities produced with University of Florida research team members. The Photo-maps literally show and tell about the barriers and facilitators they encounter when seeking and receiving breast health screening. The Photo-maps are followed by questions that pertain to specific actions that providers/facilities might consider important to improving the level of care provided to their patients with physical disabilities.
