The JP-PAS Program was created by the Florida Legislature to help working adults with significant disabilities obtain and maintain competitive and integrated employment. The program provides a monthly reimbursement to eligible individuals to help offset the cost of the personal care assistance they rely upon to help with daily activities.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- ❑ Individuals must be employed and be able to acquire and manage a Personal Care Attendant
- ❑ May not receive SSI, SSDI or Medicaid Home and Community-based Services
- ❑ Be at least 18 years of age
- ❑ Be a United States Citizen or Legal Permanent Resident
- ❑ Be a Florida resident
- ❑ Must require personal assistance services for support for at least two activities of daily living, such as ambulation, bathing, dressing, eating, grooming and toileting as defined in F.S. 429.02
